

Ministry Updates: Liturgy, Sacraments, and Maintenance

Growth (Where We've Been)

- » 14 weekly masses with over 1,200 people attending Mass each weekend, and hundreds daily
- » An adult choir, thirty members strong, beautifully singing hymns, chants, mass settings, and four-part harmonies
- » Two children's choirs building out the next generation of music at St. Anthony's, and close to fifty altar servers
- » Replaced roofing across all of our buildings and restored our steeple cross
- » Updated wiring and electrical service that brings us safely up to code
- » Updated classrooms and CGS atriums where our students grow in the faith
- » Updated security systems in all of our buildings

Hope (Where We're Going)

- » Continued recruitment of year-round cantors, choir members, and sacristans
- » Training of new organists, and increased repertoire for our choir
- » Formation and ordination of new deacons
- » Continued updates to door security for advanced parishioner access
- » Improvement and maintenance of our marian garden
- » Holistic interior renovation of our historic church
- » Updated hymnals granting access to four-part harmony for the entire congregation
